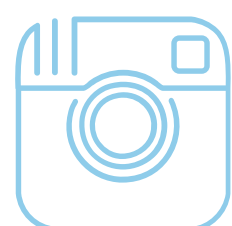


# Paper Penguin Pals

- First take the cutouts of each part required to make your new friend (body, beak, belly, feet, and eyes).
- Next take the three colored papers along with the glue provided within your kit.
- Now with help from a trusted adult, get a pair of scissors so you can begin cutting out and around the shapes provided.
- Then put each part of your friend by their respective colors (black for the body, orange for the beak and feet, and the belly doesn't require a color).
- You're now ready to assemble your penguin, starting with the face! Take glue stick and googly eyes from your kit, along with the beak you cut out for your penguin.
- Carefully apply glue to the back of the googly eyes then stick them to where the penguins face is meant to be, then apply glue to the beak and place it below the eyes
- Upon doing that, take the belly of your penguin and prepare to glue it below their head
- Now your friend is nearly complete, just turn them around and apply glue to where their feet are meant to be.
- Once you applied more glue, take the little feet you made for them and attach them to where the glue was applied.
- Turn them back around and say hello to your new buddy who's now ready to spend the holidays with you and your family!
